



Looking after your Lambswool Over Rugs

With a little care, your over-rugs will give you years of service.

The specialist sheepskins we use are tanned to naturally resist soiling so unnecessary heavy cleaning should be avoided, We recommend a regular shake and vacuum to remove any loose grit which may accumulate.

If your rugs get wet, let them dry naturally - do not tumble or force dry.

Mud should be allowed to dry and then vacuum the rugs to remove any dust and debris left.

Oil-based spillages can be removed using natural, orange-based cleaning agents.

For heavier soiling, we recommend general wool-safe carpet cleaner

You will need; a supply of clean warm water, general wool-safe cleaner in a trigger-type dispenser, clean cloth, and a vacuum cleaner with nozzle fixing.

- Start by giving the over rugs a thorough vacuuming
- Gently MIST the Cleaner over the surface - do not over soak
- Using a clean DAMP cloth GENTLY clean the wool fibers - do not oversoak and regularly rinse and wring out the cleaning cloth. Repeat as necessary
- Vacuum the rug using the nozzle appliance and repeat regularly as the rugs dry - this will help the wool fibers to recover
- Let the rugs dry naturally. Do not tumble or force dry
